

Key Stage 4 2022 - 2023 Results

All learners when joining Three Towers are deemed unable to be educated in mainstream schools. Learners join and leave Three Towers throughout the academic year. They may leave Three Towers for a number of reasons such as moving to a more appropriate provision for their needs, returning to mainstream education or moving out of the area. Some learners were involved in the provision since from the start of Y10 whilst other learners entered the provision during the spring term of year 11. All our learners are given a pathway appropriate to their individual needs and ability, which include a wide range of qualifications and accreditations.

Commentary

Three Towers headline figures show positive outcomes and shows an upward trend from the outcomes of 2019 (last exam series) for 5x 4+ grades inc. English and maths, and 5x 1+ grades including English and maths.

The cohort this year has significantly reduced from that in 2019 from 76 to 40 which has had an impact on overall outcomes. Attendance has also been a contributing factor, Attendance for year 11 in 2018/19 was 34.7% and in 2022/3 was 36.6%. With this taken into account the data is comparable to that of 2019.

60% of learners achieved at least 1 GCSE or equivalent and overall, 5% of learners achieved at least a grade 4 in English and maths and 2.5% achieved a grade 5 in English and maths.

85% of learners achieved at least one accreditation. Those who did not achieve any accreditation was either due to persistent absence or did not attend one of the exam papers which resulted in a U grade.

As a provision, in the academic year 2022/23, Three Towers offered 23 different types of qualifications ranging from GCSEs to BTECs to other accreditations. This highlights the amount of personalisation we offer our learners and the high expectations we have for all our learners regardless of ability or background. We work hard to ensure that leaners study courses that are best suited to progress into the next stage in their education.
