

Key Stage 4 2021 Results

All learners at Three Towers were deemed unable to be educated in mainstream schools. Some learners were involved in the provision since from the start of Y10 whilst other students entered the provision during year 11. All our learners are given a pathway appropriate to their individual needs and ability, which include a wide range of qualifications and accreditations.

The Covid pandemic has had a significant impact on the learners but with the introduction of Teacher assessed grades learners were credited with the grades that they worked hard for. Comparisons cannot be made with other years at the Three Towers or against the National & regional data due to no exams taking place over the last two years

Commentary

We offered 34 different types of qualifications showing the amount of personalisation we provide for the learners to cater for their different backgrounds and to ensure they study courses that are best suited to progress into the next stage in their education.

81.7% of learners achieved at least 1 GCSE or equivalent and overall 91.7% of learners achieved at least one qualification. Those who did not achieve any qualification was due to persistent absence.

There were no appeals against any TAG's that were submitted to the exam boards. The sample submitted to the exam board for quality assurance purposes was of a high standard and AQA did not request further samples or evidence. All grades submitted through the TAG process were not changed by the exam board
