Dear Parent/Carer,

I regret to inform you that I have been made aware today that a Year 11 learner has received a positive COVID-19 test result. The learner was tested over the weekend having developed symptoms late Friday night and received their result yesterday; school received this information last night. The last day that the learner was in school was Friday 6<sup>th</sup> November.

I have implemented advice given from Public Health England and tracked any learners that the individual had close contact with on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> and Friday 6<sup>th</sup> November. All learners who are being directed to self-isolate have been contacted separately. Your child is not included in this group and should continue to attend school.

We are continuing to follow the safety measures already in place, which include:

- Ensuring learners stay within their year groups at lunchtimes
- Encouraging physical distancing wherever possible
- Directing learners to sanitise their hands on arrival and continue to wash/sanitise their hands regularly throughout the day
- Ensuring that there is an enhanced cleaning schedule in place throughout the school day
- Providing students with equipment
- Implementing staggered lunchtimes and finishing times
