## Subject Specific – Maths



MathsWatch is an online resource giving you access to various tools to help towards achieving your full potential at Mathematics. With MathsWatch, you can now access video tutorials, which explain topics just like a teacher would at the board. You can independently practice real exam-style questions with instant feedback on your performance. Finally, you can also complete assignments set by your teacher with instant feedback provided to both you and your teacher.


To log in follow the following instructions:

- Login is your first initial followed by your surname with no gaps @ttapa

Example: **jbloggs@ttapa**

- Password is: **3towers**

You can then go to the tab on the top to videos, watch maths clips then answer exam style questions and it will give you immediate feedback.



MyMaths is an online resource that will help you practice and revise different topics with lessons and homework tasks available. Some of the topics now also have video support to talk you through just as a teacher would. You are able to independently complete the homework tasks and it will mark it, giving your instant feedback.
